Enjoying Obedience

DISCIPLINE: CELEBRATION & HOSPITALITY

"Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it."

— Luke 11:28, NIV —

In Jesus' estimation, the well-off ones are those who listen to God's instructions and obey. This is radically different from how happiness is offered to us in the world — where happiness means serving ourselves, satisfying our every impulse and desire and ambition. Those who chase after this kind of happiness quickly find that it satisfies, but fleetingly. Jesus invites us to discover true joy and celebration through lives of joyful obedience to him.

Celebration transforms every act of service and sacrifice into an experience of God's goodness and love for us.

"We engage in celebration when we enjoy ourselves, our life, our world, in conjunction with our faith and confidence in God's greatness, beauty, and goodness."

Consider the life of righteousness that God has called us into by his grace. What is one area where you know you struggle to serve God and obey him? For example, maybe you know your speech can sometimes show "anger, rage, malice, slander" or even "filthy language" or lying (Colossians 3:8-9). And you know that God desires your speech to be "always full of grace, seasoned with salt" (Colossians 4:6). Which kind of speaking would you describe as joyful?

Many well-intended Christians struggle to obey God because they do so out of a fearful obligation (Romans 8:15) in small periods between living for themselves, and then grumblingly wonder why they don't feel the joy of the Lord. God will give you joy (a fruit of His Spirit) as you surrender yourself to his service and worship wholeheartedly.
