DISCIPLINE: CELEBRATION & HOSPITALITY

Sing praises to God, sing praises; sing praises to our King, sing praises!

— Psalm 47:6 —

Singing is an incredible gift from God, with wonderful benefits for our lives. It connects our minds and bodies, reduces stress and pain, bonds us with others when we sing together, and expresses emotions in a creative and positive way. When we sing, we are engaging our heart, mind, and body, in concert together. And God asks us to direct our singing to him, adding our spirit to the mix!

"Be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."
