The Bible Recap

"If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and he will deliver us from Your Majesty's hand. But even if he does not, we want you to know, Your Majesty, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up." -Daniel 3:17-18

Coming before King Nebuchadnezzar, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego do not hesitate to state their faith in God and to reject worshiping the golden statue. Although confident that God could save them from the fiery furnace, they do not put their trust in that outcome. Their trust is fully in God.

C.S. Lewis tell this story:

"Two men had to cross a dangerous bridge. The first convinced himself that it would bear them, and called this conviction Faith. The second said, "Whether it breaks or holds, whether I die here or somewhere else, I am equally in God's good hands." And the bridge did break and they were both killed: and the second man's Faith was not disappointed and the first man's was."

Today ask yourself:

Is my faith in an outcome? Or is my faith that I am in God's good hands?
