- 1. In 1 Corinthians 15, Paul points out that the Corinthians' disbelief in the resurrection has led them into sin and debauchery. How can we know which doctrines should be held as absolute verse conditions or opinions?

### The Bible Recap

#### **Examining Scripture**

those in Thessalonica, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true." - Acts 17:11

After Paul's miraculous conversion, he became one of, if not, the greatest missionary of his day, and perhaps all time. He would preach the good news of Jesus first to the Jewish communities then to the Gentiles. Although some would reject his message and at times attempt to kill him, others would be hungry for his words. In the city of Berea he found a community of Jews that didn't just accept what he was telling them at face value. Instead they compared what Paul was saying to the Holy Scripture they had at the time.

The Bereans are an amazing example of what we should do. Taking everything as it is given to us is not what God intends, as we are told in 1 John 4:1-3:

"Now the Berean Jews were of more noble character than

"Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world."

So like the Bereans, let us test what we receive to determine if it is really from God.
