Reflection and Discussion Questions

- 1. In Romans 1, Paul talks about how God is righteous to judge sinners. In chapter 2, he talks about the necessity of the law. Then in chapter 3, he talks about the free gift of salvation, generously given by the grace of God, though no merit of our own. How does remembering our sin and brokenness in light of God's justice help us to better understand our salvation? Would you praise God for His gift if you were under the false impression that you deserved it?

The Bible Recap

Church Discipline

"He will also keep you firm to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is faithful, who has called you into fellowship with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord." 1 Corinthians 1:8-9

As Paul goes on his missionary journeys, he helps set up many churches in many cities in Greece. He does not stay very long at any location, but instead he finds leaders to take up the mantle of pastor in their own congregations. One of these churches is in the city of Corinth. It's not long before he begins receiving word of problems happening in the church with immorality, divisions, and wrong practices of the Lord's supper, amongst other things. Paul writes epistles, or letters, to this church to build them up, strengthen them, and to correct their false doctrine.

Sometimes as God's church we get things wrong. Sometimes our practices have been wrong for a generation, and we fail to realize it. And sometimes these false doctrines and false practices need to be disciplined. As maturing disciples of Jesus we should always be open to the discipline of the church, for through discipline comes much growth in the Holy Spirit. Using Paul's letters as a reference, we can discover how realigning ourselves with Jesus can help us grow.
