Covenants

And he blessed Joseph and said, “The God before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, the God who has been my shepherd all my life long to this day, the angel who has redeemed me from all evil, bless the boys; and in them let my name be carried on, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth.”

-Genesis 48:15-16 ESV

The book of Genesis; the book of beginnings. Throughout this entire book we see how God began His covenants with mankind. Starting with His covenant with Adam, God promised that through Adam's line a Savior would come to undo the curse of sin that Adam had brought into the world. Going on, God made a covenant with Noah that He would not wipe out the world with a flood ever again. Next God makes a covenant with Abraham that he will be a great nation, and he will be a blessing to all nations through the Savior who will come through his line. That covenant passes down to Isaac, then Jacob and Jacob's sons. Although this book is very well known, we might miss some of the deeper truths. The one true hero of this story is God alone. He is the one providing for His people. He is the one who never breaks His covenants even when the other party fails to uphold their ends. And He is the one who brings all of His promises to completion.
