The Bible Recap

Bezalel and Oholiab

“See, I have called by name Bezalel the son of Uri, son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with ability and intelligence, with knowledge and all craftsmanship, And behold, I have appointed with him Oholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan. And I have given to all able men ability, that they may make all that I have commanded you:”

Exodus 31:2-3, 6 ESV

When the Israelites arrived at Mount Sinai and Moses went up to meet with God, God gave Moses detailed instructions about how the Tabernacle is to be built. He also informed Moses that His spirit would fill two men, Bezalel and Oholiab, to head up the construction of the whole project of building the Tabernacle including all of the furnishings and the priestly garments. They had to be able to work with many different materials, such as wood and gold and silver and brass, but also with animal skins and different yarns. Thankfully God also supplied many men with the ability to do all this work. We live in a time where God’s Spirit fills all believers. It is the Spirit that empowers us, just as it did with Bezalel and Oholiab. When God has a task for us to complete, He doesn’t expect us to do it in our own power. His Spirit will work through the abilities God gave us to accomplish His plan. And God doesn’t just work through individual people anymore. He is also empowering others around us so that we might work together as fellow believers to achieve the goals that God has for us. Just like God appointed Oholiab to help Bezalel, as well as giving many men abilities to help, so God has given us and those around us abilities to do the work. What God initiates, He will sustain. What He sustains, He will fulfill. And He will do all of this according to His plan.
