The Bible Recap

Grumbling at God. And the whole congregation of the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness, and the people of Israel said to them, "Would that we had died by the hand of the Lord in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the meat pots and ate bread to the full, for you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger." Exodus 16:2-3 The Israelites were hardly a month and a half out of Egypt when they started complaining about what they didn't have. They felt that God was not going to supply their needs for food and water, and they began to fantasize about how good it had been in Egypt. Not only were they were quick to forget about the hardships of the slavery they had just come out of, but they were also quick to forget about the awesome power God had displayed to get them out. Although it is easy to judge the Israelites' lack of faith as they were so quick to forget about God's saving power, the reality is that we are not any better. Things might be going along smoothly when all of a sudden life throws up a roadblock. We are quick to fall into the same habit of grumbling at God. If something isn't going right, then why shouldn't we complain about it? If our neighbor has something better than us, why shouldn't we compare and make judgments? Our doubts and resentment show God that we don't believe that what He has for us is the best. We must ask God to replace our earthly desires with God's eternal promises to us.
