The Bible Recap

Priests, Feasts, Sacrifices, and Purity

As the book of Leviticus comes to a close, you may be left with a feeling of confusion over this ancient culture of priests, feasts, sacrifices, and purity. If we direct our focus to what God is saying though, we see His desire to be in relationship with His people. Also these books of the law lay down the foundation for Jesus.

Hebrews 9:11-14 says:

But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things that have come, then through the greater and more perfect tent (not made with hands, that is, not of this creation) he entered once for all into the holy places, not by means of the blood of goats and calves but by means of his own blood, thus securing an eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls, and the sprinkling of defiled persons with the ashes of a heifer, sanctify for the purification of the flesh, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.

Leviticus gives the context to our modern ears to understand the significance of Jesus sacrifice. We thank God for every part of scripture, especially those that challenge our understanding, but reveal more clearly God's love for us.
