The book of Psalms is full of prophecies about the coming Messiah. A couple that we read this week are about His crucifixion.

“Into your hands I commit my spirit” Psalm 31:5

“Jesus called out with a loud voice, ‘Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.’ When he had said this, he breathed his last.

Luke 23:46

“He protects all his bones, Not one of them will be broken.”

Psalm 34:20

“But when they came to Jesus and found that he was already dead, they did not break his legs.” John 19:33

These prophecies were written hundreds of years before they were fulfilled. There are other Psalms that prophecy other events around the crucifixion such as Psalms 16, 22, 69, and 109. During this Easter season, it is important to remember that all of this had been ordained long before Jesus went to the cross.
