The Bible Recap

“Adam, Seth, Enosh, Kenan, Mahalalel, Jared, Enoch, Methuselah, Lamech, Noah. The sons of Noah: Shem, Ham and Japheth.” -1 Chronicles 1:1-4

We are over 100 days into reading the Bible this year, and we've come across many challenges. For some, getting through the laws in Leviticus is one of the hardest things. For others it is getting through large genealogies. The book of 1 Chronicles starts with the largest genealogy in the Bible. For eight chapters, three of which we will read next week, we are given a large overview of people born into Adam's race all the way down through Israel's pre New Testament survivors. Sometimes it is difficult to sit down with a passage like this. It is hard to see how it has any relevance to us today. But we need to understand that the Bible is not about us. It is about God and His faithfulness. The book of Chronicles was written to the Jews returning from exile in Babylon to show them that God has kept His promise to preserve a remnant of them. The genealogies are written proof that God is faithful in every generation.
