“How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in unity! -Psalms 133:1 A psalm of David.

Although we haven't gotten to the divided kingdoms of Israel and Judah that we will see in the book of Kings, the nation of Israel has not really been united in a common purpose since the book of Joshua. The book of Judges was one disaster after another up to the point of rejecting God and asking for a king. God gave them their desire in the form of Saul, and the division grew in different ways. But God has prepared for this. He has anointed David, a man after God's own heart, to become Israel's next king. Now, after years of trial, heartache, and betrayal, David is finally recognized as the king over all of Israel. He conquers Jerusalem, the formerly insurmountable city, and makes it the nation's capital. With its strategic location between the land of Judah, David's home, and the northern tribes of Israel, David is declaring the unity of the nation under the one true God, and as we will see, “How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in unity!”
