But you will have a son who will be a man of peace and rest, and I will give him rest from all his enemies on every side. His name will be Solomon, and I will grant Israel peace and quiet during his reign. He is the one who will build a house for my Name. He will be my son, and I will be his father. And I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel forever.” (1 Chronicles 22:9-10)

David had a great desire to do something great for God. But God denied him the chance to build Him a house. Instead God promises that David’s son would build a house for His Name. In preparation, David gathered many of the materials that would be needed in the temple construction.

When Solomon became king, he began work on the temple. It took seven years for the temple to be complete, and never was a hammer or chisel heard from the building site. At the completion of the temple, the ark of the covenant was brought inside, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple, similar to when the tabernacle had been completed. God fulfilled His promise to reside with His people.

Today God continues to fulfill that promise by residing in his disciples. 1 Corinthians 3:16-17 says, “Do you not know that you yourselves are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in you? If anyone destroys God’s temple, God will destroy him; for God’s temple is sacred, and you are that temple.”
