Reflection and Discussion Questions

1. Why is it important to remember who God is speaking to when He makes promises like the one in 2 Chronicles 7:14? What can go wrong when we misapply God's promises?
2. Read Psalm 150:2 aloud. This verse praises God for His "mighty deeds" and His "excellent greatness". The first focuses on what He does, and the second focuses on who He is. How are those two things different, and why is that important?
3. **What was your favorite "God Shot" this week? What did you learn about His character from these readings?**

Wisdom

David's life has run its course, and his son Solomon succeeds him as the king of Israel. Early in his reign God appears to him and tells Solomon to ask for anything he wants. Solomon doesn't ask for money or long life or destruction of his enemies. Instead he asks God for the wisdom to rule the nation of Israel. God is pleased with his request and grants him wisdom along with the things he didn't ask for. Solomon immediately becomes known for his wisdom, and many come to him seeking his counsel. In fact, most of the book of Proverbs is accredited to Solomon and he becomes known as the wisest man ever to live.

In the New Testament, Jesus tells people that he is greater than Solomon, that the people of Solomon's day responded positively to Solomon, and how much more the people of Jesus' day should respond to one greater. Through Christ's death and resurrection we are given a direct line to God the Father to receive wisdom. James 1:5 states: "If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him." The wisest thing we can do as disciples of Christ is to ask Him for the wisdom that He is ready and willing to give us. Now go forth and walk in the wisdom of God.
