The Bible Recap

Bible Recap: Give Me Living Water (John 4:5-26)

Jesus came to Samaria, on a hot and humid day. Being tired from His journey, at Jacob's well He would stay. A Samaritan women came, to draw water so cool and clear. Jesus said, "Give Me a drink" as the woman stood very near. Sir, you are a Jew, and with Samaritan's they do not deal. If you knew the gift of God, I would give living water that will heal. You have nothing to draw water, so what water do you have to give? The water I have is spiritual, so that one might forever live. Give me this wonderful water, that I may never thirst again. "Go get your husband," but she couldn't, for she was living in sin. Sir, I think you're a prophet, should we worship here or there? A time is now coming, where God is worshiped everywhere. God is truly a Spirit, with worship in spirit and truth He is pleased. So all must seek to worship, in spirit and truth on bended knees. I know the Messiah is coming, the Christ for all to seek. The One who you look for has come, the Christ that you seek it is Me. And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst." (John 6:35) "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." (John 7:38)
